



## ▶ WHAT TO BRING TO AUTUMN LEAVES


Not sure what to pack? Use this helpful list to ensure you have everything you need during your stay.

### Medicare & Insurance Cards

#### CLOTHING

- Multiple sets of comfortable clothing, e.g. tee shirts, athletic pants, or shorts if you have had leg surgery). Please bring seven outfits.
- Soft-soled shoes such as tennis shoes with non-skid soles, and/or the shoes you plan to wear home
- Undergarments and socks.
- Pajamas and non-skid house slippers.
- Everyday outerwear, e.g. button- or zipper-front shirts or jackets to help you practice dressing.

#### TOILETRIES/PERSONAL ITEMS

- Your personal care supplies
- Hairbrush and/or comb
- Make-up/cosmetics
- Dentures, partials, and/or glasses, if applicable
- CPAP or BiPAP, if applicable
- Laptop or tablet (free Wi-Fi)
-  You will not need cash. Medications will be provided.

During your Road to Recovery, Autumn Leaves is designed to bring together the rehabilitation therapies, support system, professional staff, and positive attitudes that work hard to get you up and moving. ***Ask questions and interact with our therapists and nurses*** so you can benefit from independent, flexible and thorough decision-making, both during your therapy program and when you return home.

## WHAT HAPPENS FROM THE HOSPITAL TO AUTUMN LEAVES?

- » Before you leave the hospital, your Case Manager/Social Worker will send a referral to Autumn Leaves. The referral authorizes our Marketing & Community Outreach Manager to verify your insurance and obtain financial approval for your stay here.
- » At the same time, the Autumn Leaves Liaison will complete an assessment of your particular health circumstances, and then review the notes and guidelines of hospital nursing staff, therapy directors, and your physician with our Health and Wellness Director to ensure Autumn Leaves is able and prepared to meet your medical and physical needs.
- » Upon admissions approval, the hospital Case Manager/Social Worker and the Autumn Leaves Marketing & Community Outreach Manager will set a discharge date from the hospital and begin plans for your transition to Autumn Leaves, including transportation.
- » When you arrive at Autumn Leaves, you will meet your nurse and other support staff members, who will get to know you, perform an assessment, and introduce you to the outstanding services and amenities at the Center. This may initially be a busy time as you meet various staff, so we appreciate your patience.
- » You will then be welcomed by a member of the Autumn Leaves therapy team within 24 hours, who will conduct an evaluation of your strength and abilities so that your customized Road to Recovery therapy program can begin as quickly as possible.
- » At the same time, the Autumn Leaves physician will be notified and all necessary treatments and orders will be verified. You will be visited by the physician within 24 hours, and he/she will follow the medical progress of your therapy. For your peace of mind, your nurse will always be able to reach the physician by phone during your stay at Autumn Leaves.
- » After you are settled in, the Autumn Leaves Admissions Coordinator will visit you to complete the admissions packet including treatment consent, code-status preference, assignment of benefits, resident agreement, and other pertinent documentation. Please be sure to have your insurance cards available, as well as any Advanced Directive or Power of Attorney (POA) paperwork.

**Note:** *You or your healthcare representative/POA have the option of completing your admissions packet prior to your admission to Autumn Leaves. Contact the Admissions Coordinator at 972-804-1735 for details.*
